



# LAUREL GLEN VINEYARD FLIGHT

## 2021 Laurel Glen “Blanc Slate” Sauvignon Blanc, Russian River Valley, CA

This Sauvignon Blanc is grown in Hopkins River Ranch, a Sauvignon Blanc vineyard in Russian River Valley planted in the 1970's. The old vines produce unusually small, intensely flavored berries. Utilizing a whole cluster press, the fruit maintains maximum freshness and ferments slowly at a low temperature to accentuate the natural richness of the grapes. The wine has delicate tropical fruit aromas, hints of Meyer lemon zest and delicious minerality. There is a beautiful richness in the mouth offset by a bright, mouthwatering acidity.

## 2019 Laurel Glen “Counterpoint” Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma Mountain, CA

This Cabernet's grapes were grown at a 1,000-foot elevation on an east-facing slope. Sonoma Mountain is a cooler place to grow cabernet than most in California, leading to lower alcohol and higher natural acidity. This keeps the wine tasting very fresh and also gives an energy to the wine. It bursts with both raspberry and ripe currant, a focused minerality and tannins that are firm, round and delicious.

## 2014 Laurel Glen Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma Mountain, CA

This wine is a perfect showcase of what Laurel Glen Vineyard does best, allow the terroir to be the star. Earthy in forest, pine and mushroom, this wine is slightly reduced and youthfully concentrated. Lively acidity supports a strong tannic structure, with a sturdy toasted oak flavor matched by a mix of black and red currant. This Cabernet is just hitting its peak era and is definitely worth stocking the cellar with.
